This morning as I was on my walk, the wind began to gently blow. It was a little chilly out as some early days are in Spring, but the snow has melted and I was more than ready to get out and go on my walks again. While I was feeling that wind, I was reminded that while you can't see the wind you can feel it. John 3:8 talks about just that: "The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes." I often times wonder why God created things the way He did and wind is something that I wonder about from time to time. We can see the results of that wind, but we just can't actually see the wind itself. What we can see is when that wind turns so strong that it brings tree limbs down, or it blows the snow or rain so hard that we have trouble seeing the road we are driving down. The wind can chill us to the bone during the Winter months but offer a refreshing breeze in an attempt to cool us off during the Summer months. That wind has a mind of its own, doesn't it? I mean we can't control it. We can't change the direction it blows from. We can't stop it nor can we start it. It can

Yet other times, it's so light that it brings the scents of newly tilled soil, the fragrance of flowers, the welcome scent from someone grilling in the neighborhood. If any of you have been in our church sanctuary when the wind blows, it makes a loud rumbling noise and sometimes makes you wonder if that's God trying to get our attention. My friends, God's love is like that wind. We can't exactly see it, but oh my, we can surely feel it. We can feel it pour over us and settle in our hearts. Encounters with God can sometimes send us to our knees or simply warm our hearts. Sometimes we feel His presence and love, and other times we simply know of that presence by faith. That wind, like God's love, grace and mercy can be so powerfully felt that we are in awe of it, and then other times it comes so quietly it feels like it whispers softly on our face and just slightly lifts our hair.
